



Return Policy

1. Failure to draw a license is the only reason that deposits will be returned. License applications withdrawn by the client will not count as failure to draw and deposits will not be eligible for refund. **Trip insurance is highly recommended to avoid losing your deposit in the event that you are unable to hunt as scheduled.**
2. To book a hunt, a deposit amounting to **50%** of the total hunt price is required. The outfitter will accept cash, a personal check, certified check or money order. The outfitter will not be responsible for cash being sent via mail.
3. If Client does not draw a license for any species that Client has put a deposit on, Client's deposit money will be refunded in full to Client within **60 days** after the license draw results have been released. The Outfitter will assume responsibility for checking draw results and notifying the Client of success/failure.
4. If a combination hunt is booked and only one species is drawn,
 - a. The Client can request a partial refund on the portion of the deposit for which he/she was unsuccessful in drawing and book as a single species hunt or cancel the entire booking for a full refund. The client may also apply the deposit toward a hunt in the next year as in section 5 below.
 - b. Clients are strongly encouraged to apply for the Wyoming Game and Fish Department "special draw" license or possess the required preference points to guarantee drawing the preferred hunting license.
5. If the Client does not draw a license, any deposits may be held by the Outfitter as a deposit for a hunt the next year at the Client's request.
 - a. The request to hold deposit money for the next years hunt shall be done within **30 days** of notification by the Wyoming Game and Fish of failure to draw. If a written agreement to retain deposit money for next year's hunt is not completed, the Outfitter shall return deposit money as required in section 3 above.
6. When the client arrives at camp, all remaining fees shall be paid in full to the Outfitter. Any money paid as a deposit shall be applied to the total hunt price. These fees shall be paid by cash, certified check or money order.
7. Please note that all hunting license refunds are handled by the Wyoming Game and Fish Department, not the Outfitter.
